### Luke 20:27-38 Overview:

Some people from a wealthy sect of Judaism came to Jesus concerning a specific theological point about which they did not believe, obviously trying to start an argument. It had to do with heaven and whether a woman who married a man who dies, and then remarries subsequent brothers, which one would she be married to in the afterlife. Jesus responded, You miss the point entirely. God is about justice: making all things right, making relationships right. God is about life—now, and then.
